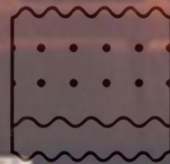

WOOD FURNITURE

As a hospitality furniture manufacturer, we craft our wood furniture to deliver timeless elegance and lasting durability, provided it is properly maintained. To preserve its finish and appearance, clean wood surfaces gently with a damp cloth and polish with a soft, dry duster. Refrain from using spray cleaners or wax-based products, as they may damage the surface or leave a sticky residue over time.

Use heat-resistant mats or trivets to shield table surfaces from direct heat or hot items. For environments exposed to high temperatures, compact laminate options are a robust alternative. To avoid scratches, always lift items instead of sliding them across the surface. Proper care will ensure your wood furniture remains a refined and functional centerpiece for your hospitality spaces for years to come.



METAL

Protect the furniture by keeping it away from harsh chemicals, which can lead to discoloration or surface damage. For added durability, use protective pads under heavy objects to minimize the risk of dents or scratches. By adhering to these care practices, your metal furniture will continue to enhance your space with its durability and sleek design for years to come.



FABRIC

Fabric-upholstered furniture brings warmth and comfort to hospitality spaces, but regular maintenance is essential to retain its appearance and durability. Vacuum fabric surfaces frequently using a soft brush attachment to remove dust and debris. Address stains promptly with a mild detergent or a specialized fabric cleaner, ensuring you test the solution on a hidden area first.

To prevent fading or discoloration, position fabric furniture away from direct sunlight. If the furniture includes removable covers, follow our care instructions for washing or dry cleaning. Periodically rotate cushions to promote even wear. With proper care, fabric furniture will maintain its inviting and fresh appearance, enhancing your space for years.



LEATHER

To maintain its luxurious look and feel, wipe leather surfaces with a soft, damp cloth, avoiding harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners that can damage the material. For spills, gently blot the area instead of rubbing to minimize the risk of staining.

Apply a high-quality leather conditioner periodically to replenish natural oils and prevent cracking or dryness. Keep leather furniture away from direct sunlight and heat sources to avoid fading or deterioration. By following these care guidelines, your leather furniture will develop a rich patina and remain a sophisticated centerpiece in any hospitality setting.



OUTDOOR

Our outdoor furniture is crafted to endure all-weather conditions, but periodic care is essential for longevity. Clean frames and surfaces with a soft cloth, warm water, and mild soap. Store outdoor furniture under shelter or use fitted waterproof covers during extreme weather to shield it from moisture and UV exposure. Ensure that cushions and fabric components are completely dry before storage to prevent mold and mildew. LAMINATE

Laminate surfaces are durable and low-maintenance, making them an excellent option for tabletops in modern furniture designs. To keep them looking their best, gently clean with a soft cloth dampened in warm water and a mild cleaning solution.

For more persistent stains, such as coffee or tea, use a non-abrasive cleaner and a soft brush to lift the marks without harming the surface. EPOXY RESIN

Epoxy resin tables are renowned for their stunning visual appeal and durability, making them a popular choice in contemporary and luxury furniture settings. To maintain their glossy finish and long-lasting performance, clean the surface with a soft, damp cloth and a mild detergent. Avoid using abrasive materials or harsh chemicals, as these can scratch or dull the resin.

For stubborn marks or sticky residue, use a non-abrasive cleaner and gently wipe the area. Avoid placing hot items directly on the table; use heat-resistant mats or trivets to protect the surface. Prolonged exposure to direct sunlight may cause discoloration, so place epoxy resin tables in shaded areas or indoors when possible.

Polishing the surface periodically with a resin-safe polish can restore its shine and remove minor scratches. With proper care, epoxy resin tables will remain a stunning focal point in any space for years to come.



WICKER / FRENCH CANE

Cane mesh, crafted from the natural rattan plant, is a timeless material known for its lightweight and elegant design. To keep cane furniture looking its best, regularly dust the surface using a soft cloth, a vacuum with a brush attachment, or a soft-bristled brush. For hard-to-reach areas, a soft toothbrush works well. Occasionally, wipe down the mesh with a damp cloth and apply a light coat of furniture polish to enhance its sheen and provide protection.

If the cane becomes heavily soiled, gently clean it with a mild soap and water solution, rinse thoroughly, and allow it to air dry. For dry or brittle cane, rehydrate the material by spraying it with a diluted mixture of oil- or glycerin-based soap, then wiping it dry with a soft cloth. A small amount of linseed oil can also be applied to deeply nourish and restore the rattan's flexibility. With consistent care, cane mesh furniture will retain its natural beauty and durability for years to come.
